- Z.B.: Wenn ich viel Geld gewinnen würde, würde ich mir ein Auto kaufen
- If + simple past , would + Infinitiv
  □ 2. Verbform Verneinung: wouldn't + Infinitiv
  □ be → was/were oder: wasn't / weren't
  □ Verneinung: didn't + Infinitiv
- Examples: If she **won** a lot of money, she **would buy** a house
  - I he didn't eat that much, he wouldn't be that fat
